Summary Explanation/Background Information:

The City of PSL Police Department received a Byrne-JAG (FDLE) grant award to purchase criminal justice information equipment and software. The Department desires to purchase 22 fingerprint software and scanners to increase their current DataWorks system. The device is on the State of Florida Contract #680-370-07-1 at a unit cost of \$2,039.00 each plus \$50.00 each for the adapter for a total package price of \$45,958.00. The contract allows for further negotiated discounts which the Department has taken advantage of to acquire the units and accessories for a total price of \$41,362.00; a discount of \$4,596.00.



Subject: Justification for Additional Fingerprint Readers

Date: December 19, 2011

We are requesting approval to purchase additional RapidID EdgeDevice (RID) fingerprint software and scanners. This is part of the ongoing FDLE mandated FALCON project. We currently have approximately 10 deployed within our mobile force. These portable units allow our officers to obtain fingerprints at the time of a contact with an individual. After obtaining the print (the subject simply places their finger on the device), it will electronically check against the FBI database for any "hits." We originally field tested this device over 4 years ago. Since that time, we have continually added these devices to our inventory. The ultimate goal is to deploy enough units for all personnel out in the field.

Recently, we were approved under the Project # Y1202 Byrne-JAG (FDLE) Award #2012-JAGC-STLU-1-C4-070 to purchase additional units. This grant will allow us to add at least 22 readers to our inventory.

These units have proven very successful by allowing our officers to have vital information regarding a suspect at the time of contact. The benefits include, but are not limited to:

1. Officer safety.
2. Apprehension of wanted individuals.
3. Avoids subject giving false information.

In addition, we have made numerous high profile arrests utilizing these devices. We are asking for approval to purchase these additional devices. These units will be added to our present DataWorks system. The pricing is based on the Dataworks state contract:
