4. REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS FOR BOARD VACANCIES (2)

Chair Magrann said, "Iva Campbell's application expired on August 3, 2011, and Patricia Simmons' application expired on August 5, 2011, but because we didn't have a quorum last month, I think we need to waive those deadlines. Mr. Holiday put in an application, as well as Roberta Humburg, and Marylou Stant. Enrique Veloz and Mr. Griffis are here today, and they have submitted their applications. Last month we discussed that we were impressed by the people that made the effort to be here, as it showed that they had an interest." Mr. Friedman commented, "Mr. Holiday cannot be considered, because he is not here all year round." Chair Magrann replied in the affirmative and said, "This position requires attendance all year round." Ms. Organ remarked, "Also, people need to confirm that they will be at the meetings, as we had an issue with attendance in the past." Chair Magrann advised, "That is why we need two more people, so we can be assured that we have a quorum. Mr. Griffis was very instrumental in organizing the New York Mets Baseball Portrait Art Fund Raiser." Mr. Griffis said, "I am a member of three art clubs: Martin County, Port St. Lucie, and the Vero Beach Art Clubs. I have input from all three of them every month." Mr. Veloz stated, "I have my Bachelors in Media Arts. My concentration was film theatre, and I also am a graduate of the New York Playhouse in Manhattan in theatre arts. The last seven years I was in corporate compliance until I moved here last year. I'm working with the Boys and Girls Club as a Case Manager. I'm also with the Burt Reynolds Master Acting class. I always needed a balance in my seven years in corporate, so I immediately found the Burt Reynolds Master Class." Chair Magrann said, "I think we have a good fit with the two candidates." Mr. Snyder commented, "By showing up, it says a lot." Ms. Organ pointed out, "And it is not the first time, so that is a good sign."

Mr. Friedman inquired, "Was everybody else notified?" Chair Magrann responded, "They all know that we meet the second Tuesday of every month." Mr. Friedman said, "Patricia Simmons was on the Arts Council, and we worked together on the Cultural Affairs Council." Mr. Snyder **moved** to appoint Enrique Veloz and Lee Griffis to the Public Art Advisory Board. Ms. Organ **seconded** the motion, which **passed** by voice vote with Chair Magrann, Ms. Organ, and Mr. Snyder voting in favor, and Mr. Friedman voting against. Chair Magrann said, "Welcome to the Public Art Advisory Board. Congratulations." The Assistant City Attorney advised, "It still has to be approved by the City Council."


