

TEFRA SCRIPT

MAYOR: This is a public hearing relating to the proposed issuance by the Martin County Health Facilities Authority (the "Authority") Hospital Revenue Bonds Series 2012 (Martin Memorial Medical Center) (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$195,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be used, together with other available moneys, to (i) finance a portion of the costs of acquiring, constructing, renovating and equipping certain health care facilities, including an approximately 82-bed acute care hospital in the City of Port St. Lucie, in St. Lucie County, Florida (the "Project"), (ii) finance or reimburse Martin Medical for a portion of the costs of acquiring, constructing, renovating and equipping certain improvements at the existing health care facilities of Martin Medical (the "Capital Improvements"), (iii) refinance certain outstanding indebtedness (the "Refunded Bonds") the Authority incurred for the benefit of Martin Medical, (iv) fund a debt service reserve fund, (v) pay capitalized interest on the Bonds through the completion of construction of the Project, and (vi) finance the costs of issuing the Bonds and refinancing the Refunded Bonds.

MAYOR: I now hereby open the public hearing upon the proposed issuance of the Bonds, which was advertised for 7:00 p.m. on November 14, 2011. This public hearing is being conducted pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982, as amended by the Tax Reform Act of 1986 (together referred to for the purposes of this hearing as "TEFRA" and embodied in Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code")). TEFRA requires that in order for the interest on the Bonds to be

exempt from federal income tax, the Bonds and the Project must be approved by either a voter referendum or by an applicable elected representative of such governmental unit (in this case the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida) after a public hearing following reasonable public notice.

A transcript of the testimony given at this public hearing will be transcribed and provided as part of the minutes of the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida (the "City Council"). Immediately following this public hearing, the City Council will, for the purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code, consider the adoption of a resolution to approve the Bonds and the Project.

MAYOR: I now present a copy of the Affidavit of Publication of the Notice of Public Hearing which was published in *The Palm Beach Post* on October 31, 2011, and direct that it become part of the minutes as Exhibit A.

MAYOR: Is there anyone in the audience who wishes to be heard regarding the proposed issuance by the Martin County Health Facilities Authority of it's not to exceed \$195,000,000 aggregate principal amount of Hospital Revenue Bonds Series 2012 (Martin Memorial Medical Center)?

Mayor identifies speakers and who, if anyone, they represent, and lets them speak.

MAYOR: The City Council will consider the adoption of a resolution approving the Bonds and the Project for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code. Under the Code and the regulations promulgated thereunder, approval by the City Council of the issuance of the Bonds as an "applicable elected representative" is a condition precedent to the interest on the Bonds being exempt from federal income taxation.

MAYOR: Hearing no further business concerning this matter, I will close the public hearing.
