Expenditure of Forfeiture Funds

Request to allow the Port St. Lucie Police Department to expend **\$30,600** of forfeiture funds in accordance to F.S.S. 932.7055(4) and Federal guidelines for the purchase of the following items: Briefing Room equipment for Patrol (includes computer and two displays) totaling \$9,950, Air Cleaning system for the Police Evidence vault (\$5,650), and Youth Court program related expenditures/supplies (\$5,000). In addition, PSLPD would like to contribute \$10,000 toward the operation of the Juvenile Assessment Center (JAC) for screening and processing delinquent youths.

Request Council approval to dispose 2 seized vehicles & M/C parts via on-line auction or similar process.


Summary Explanation/Background Information:
