

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on Saturday, July 21, 2012, the Marine Industries Association of the Treasure Coast in conjunction with the Florida Inland Navigation District will conduct the 5th Annual Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup; and

WHEREAS, this event will attract over 900 volunteers who will participate in cleaning up the waterways of St. Lucie, Martin, and Indian River Counties, and numerous waterfront homeowner associations have also been recruited to clean up their waterfronts; and

WHEREAS, 21 designated sites throughout the three counties will serve as registration and disposal sites for the volunteers to work out of; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, over eight tons of trash were collected from approximately 125 miles of waterways, with an expectation of a significantly larger amount to be collected this year with an increased volunteer effort.
