

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM TO A QUALIFIED NONPROFIT SELECTED PURSUANT TO A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie ("City") has acquired certain residential property ("NSP home") with funding provided by the federal government for its Neighborhood Stabilization Program ("NSP"); and

WHEREAS, the City has rehabilitated the NSP home which has been marketed but remains unsold; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Request for Proposal soliciting nonprofits to submit proposals for affordable housing rental or homeownership; and

WHEREAS, M.I.S.S, a Florida nonprofit corporation, submitted a proposal which provides for rental; and

WHEREAS, M.I.S.S was selected as the only bidder by the Community Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the future conveyance of the NSP home to the qualified nonprofit.

NOW THEREFOR, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That there is hereby authorized the future conveyance to the qualified nonprofit of the NSP home located at 333 SW Belmont Cir., Port St. Lucie, FL and more fully described as:

LOT 31, BLOCK 3312 OF FIRST REPLAT IN PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION FORTY TWO, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 18, PAGE(S) 18, 18A TO 18J OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Section 2. The Mayor and/or City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the conveyance of the NSP home listed

herein to the nonprofit selected under the Request for Proposals for Affordable Housing Homeownership and/or Rental.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately after its final adoption.

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Attached is an Ordinance for the conveyance of residential property acquired by the City of Port St. Lucie under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. This home was marketed but could not be sold. Community Services prepared a Request for Proposal soliciting nonprofits to accept the transfer of the unsold properties in order to offer them for affordable homeownership or rental programs. The M.I.S.S. Inc. of the Treasure Coast (M.I.S.S.) was the only bidder and was selected to receive one home at 333 SW Belmont for rental purposes; Council approved of the contract on June 25, 2012. This ordinance will allow the transfer of property to the nonprofit for the purposes and under guidelines specified in the contract.
